2. Review of Responses from Community Event and Household Survey

3. **Analysis**

440 households in the village, with 148 responding, giving us a 32% completion rate. We have met the required percentage ratio.

A question was asked if there were more responses from certain roads. Also is car parking an issue by post code.

4. Next Steps, Land designation, stakeholders, community event no. 2

- Meet with the Diocesan board to tell them the results of the survey. What options are they open for? Provide an opportunity for them to present at the next community event.
- Set up an informal event for potential volunteers to meet with the Neighbourhood Plan team.
- Start publishing an update each month in the Parish News
- Develop policies for Brown Field sites Samuels Farm, Hunsdon Skips. Looking at general criteria, and positives if developed. What things to be considered before planning.
- Develop an Action Plan.
- Show what projects we want for the village.
- Traffic calming comes as an Action point.
- Show important views, i.e. Church across to Olives Farm
- Designate Green spaces why its special and evidence as to why.
